## Dialogue with Dictators: The Costs and Benefits of High-Level Diplomacy with North Korea

What can be gained from holding high-level summits with a "rogue state" like North Korea? Do those potential gains outweigh the risk of lending prestige and legitimacy to a dictorial regime?
