"SECURITAINMENT": Triangulations of Embodied Al, Entertainment, and Surveillance

CCTV cameras are installed almost everywhere in Tokyo and other Japanese cities, and private security systems, introduced in the 1980s, are now standard in most homes. Surveillance is also embedded in everyday life, work, and play and has become "a way of seeing" and influences "ways of being seen." In this presentation I explore how and why AI-enabled entertainment and surveillance technologies have become fused, and speculate on the consequences of their triangulation.
